

## Checklist for Applicants to Graduate Programs at Truman State University

### General Comments:

International applicants should apply through the International Student Office.

Applicants who attended or are attending Truman State University do not need to request Truman transcripts; they will be requested by the Graduate Office.

### Deadlines:

The Education program accepts applications during the fall and spring semesters with deadlines of October 31 and March 31.

Applicants for other programs who are planning to begin their programs in the fall semester and who are applying for GT/RA positions should complete their applications by February 15.

**Otherwise**, application deadlines are as follows:

Fall semester – June 1

Spring semester – November 1

Summer semester – April 1
